

CASE REVIEW: *Total Shoulder Arthroplasty for A-2 Glenoid*

PATIENT HISTORY

61-year-old-right-hand-dominant man with more than 5 years of progressive shoulder discomfort. After failing all conservative measures, he sought a second opinion. He had not been able to thread his belt for about 15 years.

Active Range of Motion:

- Elevation 100
- ER 30 (at the side)
- Abduction 70
- Internal rotation to the mid lateral iliac crest 70



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A Total Shoulder Arthroplasty with the rotator interval approach using an inset glenoid was performed. It was completed as an out-patient surgical procedure.
